Most significantly, based on the Pennsylvania School Performance Profile (SPP), Agora’s overall score increased 10.2 points, from 37.7 in 2015-16 to 47.9 in 2016-17.

“That dramatic 28 percent year-to-year jump reflects numerous program improvements introduced by our highly-qualified and extremely dedicated faculty and staff,” said Dr. Michael Conti, CEO of Agora. “Our students deserve genuine congratulations for their hard work and enthusiasm for learning.”

The rise in Agora’s SPP score is largely attributable to indicators of academic growth as measured by the Pennsylvania Value Added Assessment System (PVAAS) in three specific areas over the past academic year:

- In Math/Algebra I, the score rose from 50 to 71.67
- In English Language Arts/English, the score rose from 50.83 to 62.83
- In Science/Biology, the score rose from 68 to 81.33

“The broad-spectrum progress of these key test results represents our best scores in recent history,” continued Conti. “They signify that we are moving in the right direction toward accomplishing our goal of preparing all learners to achieve their highest potential.”
