



DUAL ENROLLMENT



What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual enrollment allows students to take college classes while they're still enrolled in high school. These classes count for both high school and college credit. High school students who complete dual enrollment may need to take fewer classes in college due to earning transferable college credit.



Who Can Apply?

- Student must be a high school student in at least your junior or senior year to be eligible for this program. You must have a cumulative grade point average of a 3.0 or higher GPA with no attendance issues.
- Once students meet Agora's eligibility requirements, they must also meet the college's admissions requirements.
 - Admission criteria may vary between colleges. Ex Transcripts, GPA, placement test etc.



Enrollment Information

- Students may enroll in up to two courses per school year with a max of four courses total during their enrollment as an Agora Cyber Charter School student.
- Students may only take dual enrollment courses in the Fall and Spring semesters.

**Dual enrollment courses are a semester long commitment.

- **Students CANNOT enroll directly with the college. Students must go through Agora counselor to approve enrollment. Any student who enrolls on their own will not have courses paid for by Agora, nor will those courses count for Agora credits.**



Courses and Grading Information



- Students will work with counselor to ensure course of interest does not conflict with current HS transcript.
- Each dual enrollment course the student completes with a passing grade will add (1) credit to a student's transcript.
- Each dual enrollment course will be weighted as an AP course on student's Agora transcript.
- To remain eligible to continue in the dual enrollment program a student must maintain a "C" or higher in the dual enrollment course in which they are enrolled.
 - Please note that a passing grade for college is a C or higher and this is different than a passing grade of a D or higher at Agora.
