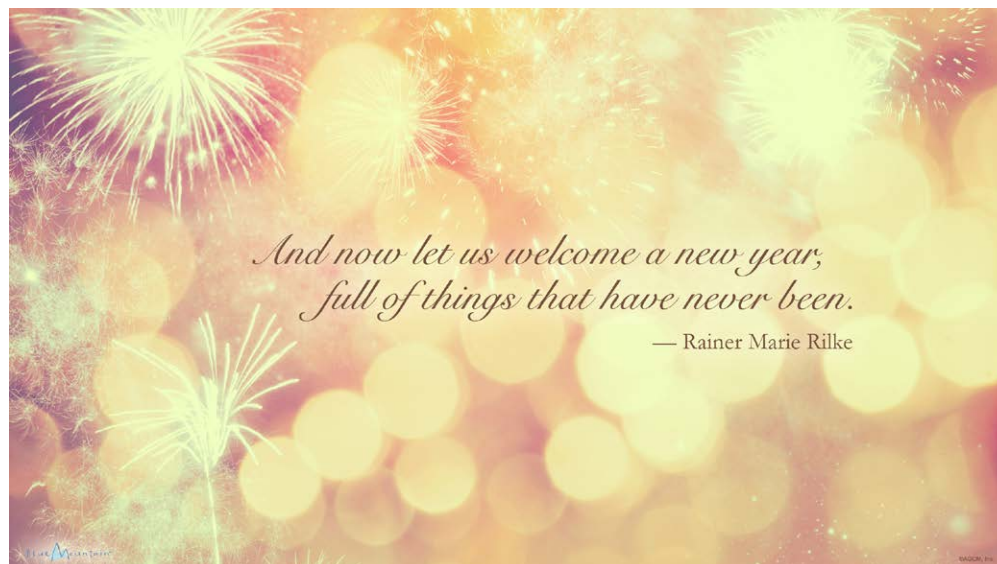

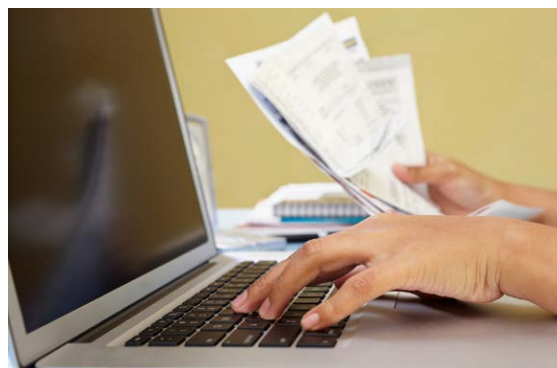
**One Last Final Reminder:

Friday, January 5 is the deadline to submit your internet bill for the Fall ISP Rebate! Parents/legal guardians can log in to the Sapphire Community Web Portal to submit for the Fall Rebate period which covers September through December and is due by **January 5, 2018**. Fall rebate checks will be mailed January 31, 2018.

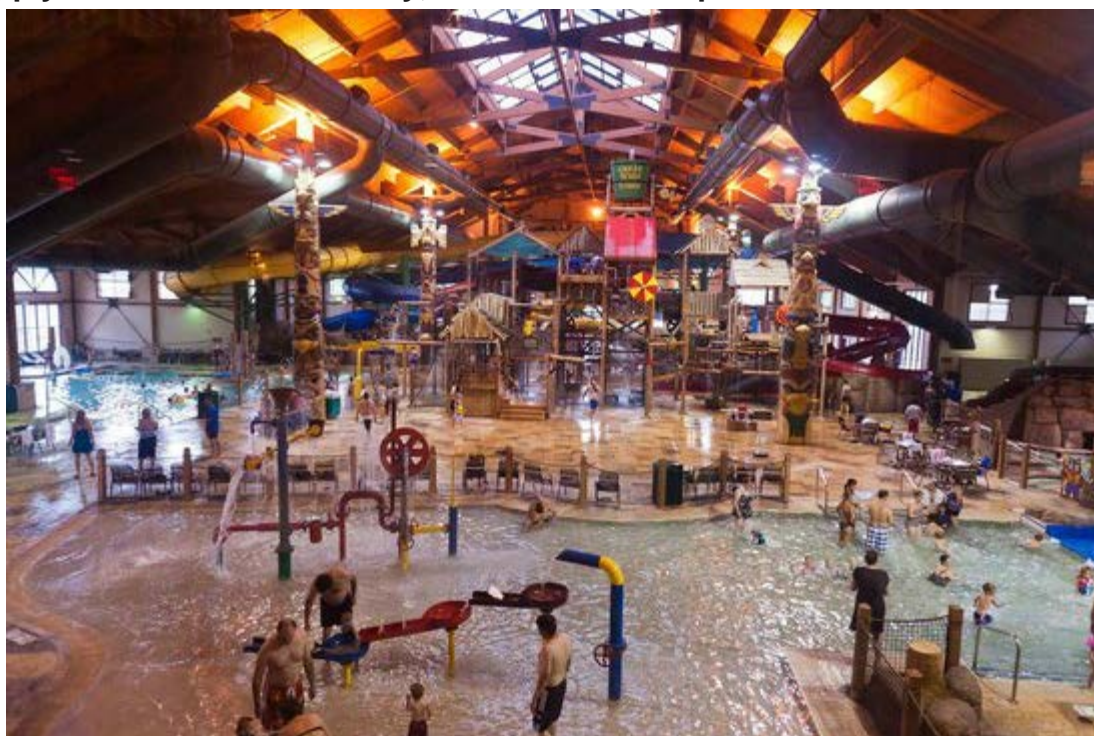

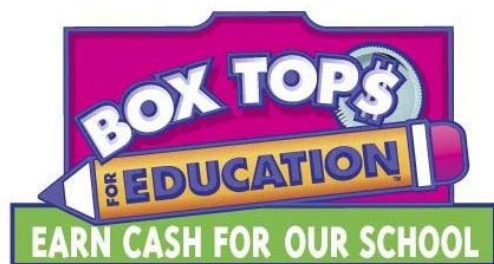
